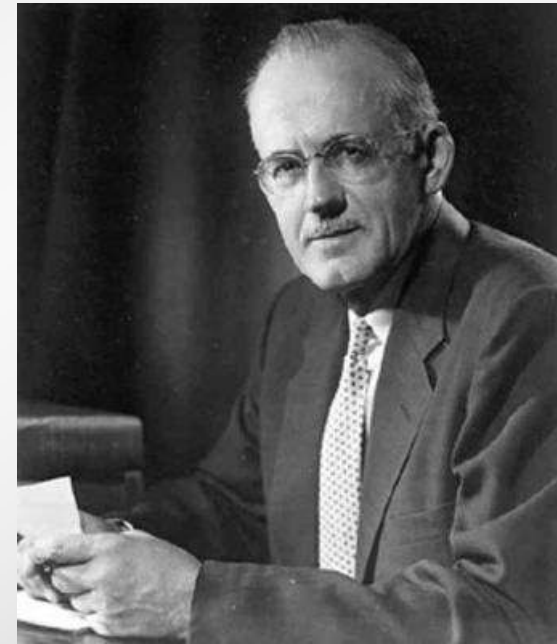


FAITH
